


























Louisville Miniature Club C- 530

The Dayton Smallworld Daytimers recently hosted a two day Electrical class. The class was taught by Carl Sahlberg from Creative Reproductions 2 Scale (www.CR2S.com). Who knew electricity could be so fun! Carl's depth of knowledge and easy teaching style made the event a success for all.

The first day, Carl explained the different ways of wiring (tape vs round wire), LEDs vs incandescent, series and parallel wiring, redundant wiring and how / when to use each of these. Further, he shared with us best practices and some of his favorite tools and when to use each. This was followed by a hands on practice session where we learned a) how to solder connections, b) making the junctions secure, c) how to fold electrical tape to minimize junctions, d) hints on hiding your wiring, and e) other miscellaneous items.

The second day we put what we had learned to practice. Each member of the class brought a project from home. Most brought small dollhouses and one member brought a miniature Dutch baby cabinet. Under Carl's watchful eye – and tutelage – we added lighting to augment what was already there or started wiring to get comfortable with finishing at home. The baby cabinet project was all about lighting on a micro scale.

From now on the Daytimers will be lighting up their mini world.




